

## Suggested Tri-C courses for students transferring to BW in preparation for teaching Mild/Moderate Intervention Specialist (Grades K-12)



This guide assists Tri-C students in selecting courses that will transfer to Baldwin Wallace University and meet some of the requirements for the Mild/Moderate Intervention Specialist (Grades K-12) teacher education program.

A maximum 62 credits transfers to Baldwin Wallace University from Tri-C, so consult with your Tri-C advisor to identify which courses fit well with your associate degree program. A BW admission counselor can also guide you in course selections.

This is not considered an A2BW Pathway curriculum because students earning an associate's degree will usually have more than two years of required coursework to complete at Baldwin Wallace to meet BW degree and State of Ohio teaching requirements.
